Goals and Objectives

The Family Medicine Clerkship will provide the medical student with a good grounding in the database and skills of family medicine as well as internal medicine and specialties. It is expected that the medical student will become familiar with appropriate diagnostic pathways, appropriate consultation, delivery of cost-efficient health care, familiarity with the psycho-social context of diseases and the acquisition of appropriate procedural skills.

Course Description

The medical student will participate in rounds with the inpatient medicine team, composed of two first year residents, one second year resident, one third year resident, and a Family Medicine Faculty Member. The medical students will also work with a first year resident (who is the primary physician for our patients on our inpatient medical service) and will see all new admissions as assigned daily. Full responsibilities of the first year resident are available upon request.
